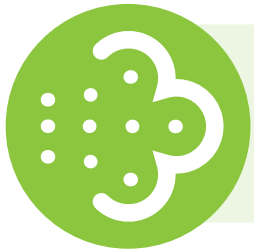
The CDC informs Patients to

Symptoms* can include:



Fever



Cough



Shortness of Breath

The only way to maintain public health right now is by staying apart, this includes social distancing – even for children. Though public gatherings are discouraged, you are still encouraged to go outside for a walk in the neighborhood or a Town park. Remember to maintain a safe distance of 6 feet apart

It is absolutely critical that we heed the advice of medical professionals. Avoid crowds, wash your hands religiously, and most importantly, remain in your home if possible.

If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop a fever and symptoms, call your healthcare provider for medical advice. Do not visit without calling ahead.

*Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure.
