

## GARBAGE & RECYCLING GUIDELINES

<p><b>Household Trash</b></p> <p><i>All kitchen and bathroom waste</i></p>	<p><b>Mon / Wed / Fri:</b> South of Schenck Ave including all properties on Schenck Ave</p> <p><b>Tue / Thu / Sat:</b> North of Schenck Ave</p>	<p>At the side or rear door of your property. No earlier than the night before pick-up.</p>	<p>Do not place household trash at the curb.</p>
<p><b>Recycling &amp; Newspaper</b></p>	<p><b>Thursday:</b> Entire village</p>	<p>At the curb no earlier than Wednesday night.</p>	<p><b>Plastics, glass and metals:</b> place in recycling can or plastic bag (clear or blue)*</p> <p><b>Newspapers/Corrugated Cardboard:</b> bundle and tie or place in a paper bag.*</p>
<p><b>Rubbish</b></p> <p><i>Anything other than household trash, yard waste or bulk items</i></p>	<p><b>Mon / Wed / Fri:</b> South of Schenck Ave including all properties on Schenck Ave</p> <p><b>Tue / Thu / Sat:</b> North of Schenck Ave</p>	<p>At the curb no earlier than the night before pick-up.</p>	<p>3 bag maximum.*</p>
<p><b>Leaves &amp; Yard Waste</b></p>	<p><b>Wednesday:</b> South of Schenck Ave including all properties on Schenck Ave</p> <p><b>Thursday:</b> North of Schenck Ave</p>	<p>At the curb no earlier than the night before pick-up.</p>	<p>5 bag maximum per week.</p> <p>Branches and twigs must be bundled and tied in 3 foot lengths.*</p>
<p><b>Bulk Items</b></p>	<p><b>Friday:</b> South of Schenck Ave including all properties on Schenck Ave</p> <p><b>Saturday:</b> North of Schenck Ave</p>	<p>At the curb no earlier than the night before pick-up.</p>	<p>1 large item per week per household.* <i>Please call Meadow Carting ahead if you are disposing of an excessively large or heavy item.*</i></p>
