# UNDER OUR FEET: THE RESILIENCY OF OUR DRINKING WATER

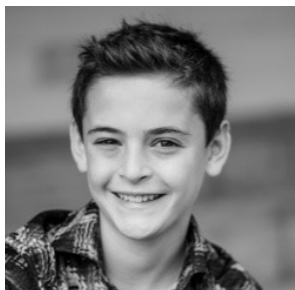
**Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at 7 p.m.**

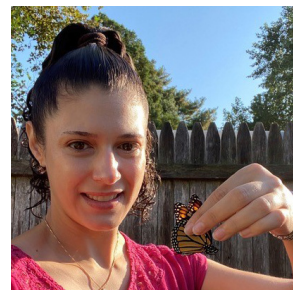
